

BUNDLE SHIPMENT EXAMPLE

3 Auctions

Step-by-step instructions:

1. Divide the overseas shipping cost of 18,400 yen by the 175 items in the shipment. The shipping cost per item calculates to 105 yen (or \$0.91* by the exact current exchange rate).

Your FromJapan invoice will detail the different categories of fees. In our example, the purchase price was paid at the time of purchase, so the remaining charges on the FromJapan invoice looked like this:

Total number of purchases	3 orders (175 items)
Weight/size (1 package)	13.17 kg – 53 cm x 50 cm x 47 cm
① Domestic delivery charges	800 yen
② Bank transfer fees	270 yen
③ Sales tax	2,304 yen
④ Overseas shipping	18,400 yen
⑤ Box fee (new)	500 yen
⑥ Total (① - ⑤)	22,274 yen
⑦ System usage fee (⑥ x 5%)	1,114 yen
Total charges (⑥ + ⑦)	23,388 yen (\$202.59*)

(* The exact currency exchange rate at the time of this transaction was 1 yen = USD\$0.008662.)

2. The above example shows the total charge is 23,388 yen by adding the other fees (domestic delivery charge, bank transfer fee, sales tax, box fee, system usage fee) onto the overseas shipping cost. Divide the total charge by the number of items (23,388 yen/175 items) in the shipment.

The additional cost per item - above and beyond the purchase price - is 134 yen or \$1.16 when you add in overseas shipping and all of the proxy fees. The \$1.16 is the amount you'll add to the purchase price for each individual item as part of the item's total acquisition cost.
